Class 1 County Prelim Teams /Individual Qualifier

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)

Section A County Prelim Restricted Individual – Rider to have only competed at prelim level **Section B** County Prelim Open level – open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

The winning team and individual from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 2 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 3 County Individual Novice Qualifiers

N24 2010 (revised collective marks 2016)

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.
