**Class 1 : Intro C – Warm Up**

**Class 2 : P7 – Warm Up**

**Class 3 : County Prelim Teams** (All team riders will also automatically be entered as an Individual in class 3A)

Open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

**Test : Prelim 12 (2005) revised 2016**

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

## **County Individual Prelim Qualifiers**

**Class 3A** : County Prelim Restricted Individual– Rider to have only competed at prelim level

**Test : Prelim 12 (2005) revised 2016**

**Class 3B** : County Prelim Open Individual– open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

**Test : Prelim 13 (2006)**

## **Class 4 : County Open Teams**

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above.

Novice section is open to all.

Teams of 3 / 4 riders, best 3 % scores to count

**Test: Prelim 13 (2006) x 2 riders (All riders will also automatically be entered as an individual in Class 3B)**

**Test: Novice 28 (2008) x 2 riders (All riders will also automatically be entered as an individual in Class 4A)**

The winner from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

## **Class 4A : County Individual Novice Qualifiers**

### **Novice 28 (2008)**

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

## **Team Qualifiers**

**Teams** (of 3 or 4, the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

**The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)**  
**If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.**
