entries will be on a first-come basis and a wait list will be held.
Late entries will be accepted with a £3 late entry fee.

Clear round – will run if time permits for an hour in the arena before the
start of the classes - £5 per round. Confirmation after close of entries.

All classes open to qualified teams and individuals. See NSEA rules on
Grassroots for additional rules.

Class 1 - 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier

(may be led/assisted) Judged on jumping penalties, placings separated on style marks. Not timed

a) led, unled and running in close proximity with the pony.

b) assisted- in the ring but does instructor not move with the pony

Class 2 GR 50cm Team & Individual Championship (may be assisted) Optimum time.

Class 3 GR 60cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted). Single Phase.

Class 4 GR 70cm Team & Individual Championship (may not be assisted). Single Phase.

Class 5 RPL 70-75cm Individual Championship. Single Phase

Class 6 RPL 80-85cm Individual Championship. Single Phase

Class 7 RPL 90-95cm Individual Championship. Single Phase

NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules 2025-26 on the NSEA website. See below for eligibility in the height classes:

Classes 1 – 4 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

Horse/rider combinations may compete in two consecutive height classes on the same pony

40 & 50 or 50 & 60 or 60 & 70cm

A GR rider may not jump in 70cm and 40cm

A rider is not eligible for GR if they are jumping 90cm and may only jump 60 and 70 GR classes if horse/rider have completed 5 x 80cm classes.

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the “spirit” of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to “pot hunt,” as it is not in the spirit of the competition. The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships

Classes 2-4 will also have a style prize awarded to the rider with the best style round.

Entry Fee - £22 per class (includes Paramedics).

Late entries £3 extra if space permits.

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules')

Prizes: Individual rosettes 1st – 6th place in each class.
Team rosettes 1st – 6th in each class.

Start Times will be available on the NSEA website, www.nsea.org.uk and at www.moretondorset.co.uk 2 days before the competition

- No horse or pony under 4 years of age may enter.

- All young children must be kept under control at all times and must not be allowed to play amongst the horses.
