Team & Individual County Qualifiers for the County Championships at Hickstead, May 2023

The RPL competition is open to schools from all Counties and will count only for RPL.

Entries to: Mrs EC Frampton Hobbs, Moreton EC – as above

Entries Close: Monday 20th February 2023 or earlier if full.

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2023 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows.

Class 1 Warm Up class

Prelim13 (2006)/N28 (2008). Highest % wins overall. (will be split if more than 12 in the class into Prelim and Novice tests).

Team Qualifiers

Teams (of 3 or 4, the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class 2 County Prelim Teams

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 3 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Individual Qualifiers

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) x 2 riders

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 4 County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Prelim 14 (2006) – this class can be entered separately to classes 2or 3 or the test can be counted for all.

3A County Prelim Restricted Individual – Rider to have only competed at prelim level **3B** County Prelim Open level – open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

Class 5 County Individual Novice Qualifiers

N27 (2007) this class can be entered separately to classes 2or 3 or the test can be counted for all.

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.
