Team Qualifiers COUNTY QUALIFIER - You may enter these classes if you are not in a Cumbrian School, however, only Cumbrian Scores to count towards the County Championship.

Teams (of 3 or 4 , the best 3 percentage scores to count)
A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class 1 County Prelim Teams - all scores to count individually also.

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016)

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 2 County Open Teams - Prelim 14 and Novice 27 - all scores to count individually also.

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders) The Novice section is open to all, up to Medium level.

Riders who have competed at any novice level dressage or above (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing must ride the novice test. They will count for the team score but not individual placings.

Individual Qualifiers

Test: Prelim 14 2006 (revised collective marks 2016) x 2 riders

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

Class 3 County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Prelim 14

3A County Prelim Restricted Individual – Rider to have only competed at prelim level

3B County Prelim Open level – open to all horse/ rider combinations

Class 4 County Individual Novice Qualifiers N27

Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)
If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.
