Class A Warm Up 60cm Non Qualifier
single phase, no style mark. Riders can be any age

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier
(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2023)
All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier
All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.
All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier
All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier a) horses and b) ponies
Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony section of the class, as the class will be split.

Entry Fee Class A = £22, Classes 1 – 5 = £ 24 per class

Rules and Conditions

- Outside assistance will NOT be tolerated and could result in Elimination
- NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground
- All competitions, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times Most of them are volunteers and rudeness is not acceptable. Have a good day!
- To be run in accordance with NSEA Rules
- all participants undertake activities at NSEA events at their own risk. Please ensure that you seek and act upon any appropriate medical advice which you receive before undertaking any activity at the event
- you are strongly advised to acquaint yourselves with the terms of the NSEA insurance cover which is provided to all registered riders and the team manager of member schools; and we will not be liable for any acts or omissions of our employees, agents and sub-contractors in relation to any activity at NSEA events or for any loss or damage suffered by you as a result of taking part in any activity at NSEA events.
- It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British standard EN1384 or PAS015 at ALL times while mounted.
 - Horses and Ponies MUST NOT be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended – please clear up any mess left by you or your horses
- **Vaccinations:** Horses and Ponies must be accompanied by their passport and must have Equine Flu vaccinations in date within 12mths. Spot checks may take place.
- **Smoking:** - No smoking or drinking of alcohol in the arena or viewing area
- All competitors/owners and their guests are required to adhere to commonly accepted standards of decency and good behaviour. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.
- No mucking out onto any indoor or outdoor areas. An immediate fine of £20 will apply if this is seen to take place.
- Litter is to be taken home with you or disposed of in the big bins provided. Please use recycling bins if provided.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

Please return any equipment used back to its storage area after use

DOGS - *Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times. Dogs must be cleared up after.*

Vehicles - The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.

Prize Givings – There will be no prize givings, ONE member from your school may collect rosettes.

Objections – Objections should be made in writing within 1hr of the incident taking place and be accompanied by a £50 deposit that will be returned if your objection is upheld.

First Aid – A total of £3 per competitor per day.

Stallions – No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury.

Close of Entries – Entries will close on the official closing date. Should space be available late entries may be accepted. Entry to the show constitutes your agreement that you, and those associated to you agree with, and are bound by the rules in this schedule

Your Responsibility

All persons attending the event must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey instructions given by the Organiser or by officials and stewards on its behalf.

All competitors and those associated with their school are the responsibility of the Team Manager whilst at the competition

The NSEA will not be held responsible for any financial loss incurred by the attendee as a result of a cancellation.
