- Objections must be made within 20 minutes of posting the results, accompanied by a fee of £10, which will be re-funded if the objection is upheld.
- All dogs on leads at all times – no exceptions. Instant £10 fine.
- The course will be open for walking between **10-5pm** on Friday 2nd September or on the day.
- It is compulsory that a riding hat that complies with the current British standard is worn at all times whilst mounted.
- It is compulsory that a body protector that complies with the current British standard is worn during the cross country phase.
- If asked to leave the cross country course for any reason, you must do as immediately at walk.
- All horses and ponies must be 4 years old and over.
- The Steward and Judges decision is final.
- Please do not muck out any lorries/ trailers in the lorry park and take all litter home.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Smoking is only permitted in designated areas and is strictly forbidden in the stable area.
- All horses and ponies must move through areas shared with pedestrians at walk.
- Outside assistance is not permitted in any phase.
- We encourage people to enter the class at their established level.
- All persons attend the event at their own risk. Moreton-Russell Events Ltd or the landowner or his employees accept no liability for damage, injury or loss to horses, riders, spectators or personal property whilst on the showground.

Estimated event guide - subject to change

Thursday or Friday - Arrival

We will be serving the normal menu at our catering wagon during the day and in the evening additional food vans will arrive with a choice of Hot Food and Pizza nights.

Friday - Dressage day

Dressage will be held in our outdoor arena.

The warm up will be marked and there will be a steward on hand to answer any queries. Please make sure you are warmed up in plenty time for your dressage slot.

The cross country will be available to walk in the afternoon/early evening and guided course walks from an international event rider will be taking place. Times will be advertised on Eventing Scores.

Saturday - Steeplechase, Roads and Tracks + XC

Warm up followed by the course of Steeplechase jumps to be completed within a set time - immediately on to the short Roads and Tracks finishing in the 10min box. 10 minute break where your horses is assessed by our veterinary team and then onto the Cross Country Track to finish.

The cross country course will be designed and build by The Willis Brothers. All jumps are solid and built to British Eventing standards. The course will be the same as our BE course so care must be taken to ensure that both the horse and rider have undertaken sufficient fitness work to avoid any injuries or unnecessary stress!

Saturday Evening

The evening will see the additional catering vans return for dinner options.

Sunday - Show jumping

A trot up will be held on Sunday morning (time to be confirmed), in front of the Ground Jury to ensure that the horses are fit and well after the cross country day.

Make sure to bring your finery as there will be a prize for best dressed. All horses should be plaited and well turned out.

Following on from this the show jumping will begin for each class in reverse order (so the leader after cross country will jump last). The course will be designed by a British Show jumping course designer and will be up to height.

Mounted Presentation of the prizes to follow.

Classes will probably run 100, 90, 80 and 70cm but we may need to change the order based on the numbers of entries. All classes are run under the guidance of British Eventing rules for Horse Trials. Horses/ponies must be at least 4 years old.
