### **Show Jumping Qualifiers SATURDAY**

**Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual SJ Qualifier**

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2023)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual SJ Qualifier**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual SJ Qualifier.**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual SJ Qualifier**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 5a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual SJ Qualifier**

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies  
( 2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify)

**SJ Entry Fee £20**

### **DRESSAGE Qualifiers SUNDAY**

**Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2023 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..**

Class 6 Prelim = P 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 7 Novice = N 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier

Class 8 Elementary = E 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

**Dressage Entry Fee £20 per test**

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules)

**The top 2 teams & 2 Individuals per section will qualify for the Championships**

*Dressage entries will be limited and will be closed as soon as they are full.*

Class 9 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on style. Not timed

Class 10 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time

Class 11 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase  
a) Restricted b) Open\*\*

Class 12 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase  
a) Restricted b) Open\*\*
