COMBINED TRAINING:-

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2023 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..

Class CT1 Combined Training Novice Qualifier

Prelim = P 13 (2006) SJ 80cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Class CT2 Combined Training Intermediate Qualifier

Prelim = P 13 (2006) SJ 90cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Class CT3 Combined Training Open Qualifier

Prelim = P 13 (2006) SJ 1m Team & Individual Qualifier

If you are also entering the Dressage P13 test for the National Qualifier (not the County) we will use your score from class A as your Combined Training score.

County Challenge Dressage Qualifiers for Cumbria county / counties and & RPL Dressage open to all (teams & individuals)

The highest placed team & individual for the relevant county will be given the title 'County Champion'

Team & Individual County Qualifiers for the County Championships at Hickstead, May 2024

Class NWU1 - Prelim 13 - a warm up test only, no qualifiers or placings.

Team Qualifiers

Teams (of 3 or 4, the best 3 percentage scores to count)

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Class CQ1 County Prelim Teams

open to 3/4 x prelim riders that have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open pony club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 12 (2005) revised 2016

The winning team from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals.

(2023 Inter-County Prelim Team Champions- Abbotsholme, Cheshire)

Class CQ2 County Open Teams

(2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders)

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Teams of 3 / 4 riders, best 3 % scores to count

Test: Prelim 14 (2006) revised 2016 x 2 riders

Test: Novice 27 (2007) x 2 riders

The winner from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (2023 Inter-County Open Team Champions – Mayfield, East Sussex)

Individual Qualifiers (to be run in conjunction with the team tests)

County Individual Prelim Qualifiers

Class CQA County Prelim Restricted Individual Prelim 12(2005) revised 2016 – Rider to have only competed at prelim level

Class CQB County Prelim Open Individual Prelim 14 (2006) revised 2016 – open to all horse/ rider combinations who have not competed at Elementary level or above, or BE Intermediate level.

Class CQC County Individual Novice Qualifiers

Novice 27 (2007) Open to rider/horse combinations not to have competed at BD Medium level or above or BE Intermediate level.

The winning individual from each respective county individual class will represent their county

at the NSEA Inter County Finals. (one per county only)

If there are two sections per class, a ride off will determine the result.

NATIONAL DRESSAGE Qualifiers

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2024 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows..

Class NSEA1 Prelim = P 13 (2006) Team & Individual Qualifier

Open to <u>horse & rider combinations</u> that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above

Class NSEA2 Novice = N 28 (2008) Team & Individual Qualifier

<u>Horse / rider combinations</u> which have ever competed at Medium level or above may not compete in Novice classes.

However, riders may compete on a different horse.

Class NSEAC Elementary = E 50 (2007) Individual Qualifier Only

No restrictions on horse or rider

Entry Fee £18per test. Refunds: No refunds or transfers after entries have closed. Late Entries £5 extra - cash on the day.

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count. Up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules)

The top 2 teams & 4 Individuals will qualify for the Championships If there is more than one section, a ride off will determine who qualifies, (or 1 team & 2 individuals per section)

Start Times will be available on the NSEA website 2 days before the competition www.nsea.org.uk and on Northern Equine Events Facebook Page.
