### Entries Close Saturday 6th April 2024

Class W 60cm Warm Up non national qualifier, (including Grass Roots Qualifier for eligible riders)

Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier (Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2024)
Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier. Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier (2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify)
Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

- It is mandatory for all riders to wear a protective helmet to British standard EN1384 or PAS015 at ALL times while mounted.
- Horses and Ponies MUST NOT be tied to the side of horseboxes or trailers and left unattended
- please clear up any mess left by you or your horses
- Vaccinations: Horses and Ponies must be accompanied by their passport and must have Equine Flu vaccinations in date within 12mths. Spot checks may take place.
- Smoking: No smoking or drinking of alcohol in the arena or viewing area
- All competitors/owners and their guests are required to adhere to commonly accepted standards of decency and good behaviour. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.
- No mucking out onto any indoor or outdoor areas. An immediate fine of £20 will apply if this is seen to take place.
- Litter is to be taken home with you or disposed of in the big bins provided. Please use recycling bins if provided.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

Please return any equipment used back to its storage area after use

## DOGS – No dogs are allowed at the showground.
