Class 2 - Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 3 - Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 4 - 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5a/b - 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier inc Hickstead Elite 1.10m

(2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify)

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies
