#### Class 1 Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2024)

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

#### Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals.

#### Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

All team riders automatically count as individuals

### Class 4 Open 1m-1.05 Team & Individual Qualifier

All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 5ab Advanced 1.10 Individual Qualifier a) horses and b) ponies Please state whether you are riding a horse or pony in the section of the class, as the class will be split.
