Entering classes

The Tweseldown Eventers Challenge will run at the following levels:

- 70 cm (XC speed 400m/minute, horses at least 4 years old and 137cm)
- 80 cm (XC speed 435m/minute, horses at least 4 years old and 137cm)
- 90 cm (XC speed 450m/minute, horses at least 5 years old and 142cm)
- 100 cm (XC speed 475m/minute, horses at least 5 years old and 142cm)

The competition comprises about 10 show-jumps, immediately followed by approximately 10 XC fences including ditches, banks and water over a distance of 800-1000m through the park. Both SJ & XC are on grass (sandy free draining). Entries must be made on www.tweseldown.co.uk opening on March 1st 2024.

If competing for NSEA make sure you enter the NSEA class. Entries close on the Tuesday before the competition or when the classes are full, whichever is earliest.

No balloting will apply – first come first served. Times will be published on the Thursday before the competition on www.eventingscores.co.uk The course will be available to walk the day before from 2pm or on the day of the competition only.

Full refunds given for withdrawals up to 3 days before competition. Discretionary refunds after that. If the competition is cancelled (e.g. due to weather conditions), then your entry fee will be refunded less a £5 admin fee.

Dress code

Please wear your normal XC attire. Your body protector and hat must comply with the 2024 BE rules. www.britisheventing.com Stopwatches are not permitted.

Competition Rules

- 20 penalties for the first refusal on the course (XC)
- 20 penalties for the second refusal on the course (XC)
- Elimination for the third refusal on the course
- Elimination for a rider fall or for a horse fall.
- Elimination for exceeding twice the Optimum Time.

Show jumping circling between fences is counted as a refusal. On the XC circling between separately numbered fences is not penalised provided you have not presented at the fence.

On the SJ if you refuse at the second part of a combination then you must jump from part A again. On the XC you can choose whether to jump part A again.

The SJ is not timed. The timing starts at the beginning of the XC phase.

Time faults XC 0.4 penalties every commenced second over the optimum time.
