TO BOOK STABLING

HICKSTEAD ONLINE PAYMENTS FOR STABLING BOOKINGS ONLY STABLING- is booked separately to entries

Stabling bookings close 9am on the Monday 19th May, or earlier if full. Stabling fees include free parking and camping, loos, showers, cleaning, security, a stable manager and an environmental fee.

Stables field gates will open at 1pm on Friday 23rd - do not arrive earlier than 1pm as the gates will be locked. If you want to park together, please meet on your journey and arrive together. Stables need to be vacated by 4pm ready for new occupants to arrive at 5pm.

Riding arenas will open at 3pm. Horses may only be ridden in walk on the grass or walkways.

Warm up class will aim to run 4-6pm.

Important information – please read

Declaration Form.

Please fill out the attached form stating where your teams / individuals qualified for both EC & County Dressage and County Show Jumping classes at the time of entering. Also state substitutes.

ALL <u>individually qualified</u> competitors must be the same horse / rider combination who qualified.

Teams- 2 horse rider combinations to be the same as at the time of qualifying for this event. Any team rider who was eliminated at the qualifier, must count as a substitute, not 2 of the original riders.

Health Check- please take your horse's temperature before leaving home. Any horse with a raised temperature, cough, unusual nasal discharge, ringworm etc, please discuss with your vet before leaving home.

Start Times will be available on the NSEA website 4 days before the competition www.nsea.org.uk

Please ensure that you do not muck out your horsebox onto the Car Park. Horses must not be left tied to vehicles unattended. Take all litter home with you.

Leave stable mucked out. All hay & droppings must be removed. All stable bookings close 5 days before the show or earlier if full. Horses wishing to stable together MUST be booked together, stating SCHOOL.

All dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Any dog mess must be cleared up.

The restaurant will be serving hot evening meals as well as food all day. There are showers in the stable area for those staying on site.

The Team Manager is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties (parents, supporters etc) at all times on the show ground.

Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must ask the stable manager where it may be pitched. No fires or camping gas cookers in the lorry park or stable field. Parents must remain on site at all times.

NSEA affiliated competitors only may warm up & compete horses on the show ground All competitors, parents and representatives from every school must ensure that they act courteously to stewards and officials at all times- most of them are volunteers and give up their time for your sport. Refunds- see NSEA Rules

The NSEA will not be held responsible for any financial loss incurred by any entrant, their associates or attendees as a result of a re-arrangement to the schedule, postponement or cancellation of a competition. All classes and jumping warm ups are on sand surfaces.

Courses will be made up of fixed XC portables, steps, banks, water etc. Skull caps with no fixed peak & body protectors (see new rules) are compulsory

Warm Up areas

A limited number of horses will be allocated to the various warm up areas at any time. These will be stewarded. A marked hacking area will also be available. Horses may not be grazed or exercised in any other area.

Numbers

Eventers' Challenge classes. Please download a NSEA number and display in your own eventing bib. DR & SJ classes may print numbers or bring **a bridle number** for each horse.

Paper numbers can be printed out from the link on the NSEA website.

Prize givings Please ensure riders are in show kit-tracksuit bottoms and hoodies won't do!

Horse walks - Stay in WALK and please pass left to left on all horse walks. Single file.

Course walks - Before each class and at allocated times during each class. No dogs in the jump arenas

Emergency Farrier will be on call, subject to availability, at your own cost. Do not bring a horse to this competition in need of shoeing or with a shoe missing!

Plaiting- horses should be plaited for all Championships classes
