2. **All stabling & hook ups to be booked only through the Addington** <https://entry.equipe.com/meetings/6430>
All other enquiries to NSEA
We recommend that each school **block books stables** for all riders in their squad if you want to be stabled together.
Please designate 1 person per school / college to book stabling and send all paperwork and payments at same time if you wish to stable together or complete the booking notes and NAME YOUR SCHOOL.
3. **Only teams and individuals who have qualified for the championships are eligible to compete at this event.**
Team Managers send the **DECLARATION FORM & INFO SHEET** to fw.nsea@gmail.com as soon as you have made your entries, deadline 1st October, after which special requests cannot be made..
4. **Please read rules carefully for eligibility for all disciplines at the show.**
All Rules for the Championship classes and qualification rules for teams can be found on the NSEA website.
5. The **Team Manager** is responsible for the conduct and welfare of their school's horses, riders and other connected parties (parents, supporters etc) at **all times** on the show ground.
Each rider will be issued with 1 extra wristband. Extra wristbands can be purchased online £4 extra prior to entries closing and will be in your school's pack at the Stable Managers Office . No wristband, no entry.
6. **Directions** to Addington and a list of local hotels and B&B's around Buckingham can be found on the Addington website
7. In accordance with Health and Safety Regulations, dogs will only be permitted in the car and lorry parks. **(Dogs are not allowed in the competition or public areas, main building, cafeteria or stable barn)**
8. Leave stable mucked out. All hay & droppings must be removed. All stable bookings close a week before the show.
9. No BBQs or chimneas in the lorry park.
10. Hook ups to be arranged with Addington.
11. **Collect wristbands for competitors and all other persons attached to the team, from the Show Secretary on arrival.**
12. All jumping courses will be raised 5cm from the qualifiers, at the Championships.
13. In the event of cancellation, entry fees shall be returned less £7 per competitor per class to help cover costs.
14. **After 10p.m, the stable area should be quiet.** Please be aware that horses need to rest and therefore noise, lighting and intrusion should be kept to an absolute minimum. Late night checks should be conducted prior to 10p.m.
15. A contact number for an adult must be left on the stable door of every horse in case of an emergency.
16. The restaurant will be serving hot evening meals as well as food all day. There are showers in the stable area for those staying on site. Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must ask the stable manager where it may be pitched. No fires or camping gas cookers in the lorry park or stable field.
17. The end of the show will be deemed to be 1 hour after the last horse has jumped.

Horses may not arrive after 10pm or before 6am unless by prior arrangement with the stable office as the stable area will be closed. A new all weather parking area has been built for large vehicles. Showers are also available.

Addington Equestrian and the NSEA reserve the right to refuse entry to, and remove, any individual without giving a reason.

SHOW JUMPING CLASSES

National Show Jumping Championships 2025

(top 8 teams & individuals to qualify for the Championships Final)

NB Competitors who are part of a team AND have qualified in the same class as an individual, only need to enter that class once but **Team Managers MUST declare all individuals to the Show Secretary on the DECLARATION FORM**

There will be a 'Best of the Rest ' prize awarded to the highest placed Team Rider (who has not also qualified as an individual) in 70-1m SJ championships classes, (scores from the first round only single phase) also dressage & JWS classes.

D1) The 30cm Rule

Any combination of horse and rider cannot compete in a jumping class at an NSEA competition, except hors concours, where the height is 30cm lower than that at which they have previously competed, (any round height) in any competition (not just NSEA competitions). This restriction does not apply to Open or Advanced Open classes. Therefore, Horse/Rider combinations jumping 1.30m or over may compete in NSEA Open or Advanced Open classes. If competing in a County Competition, please also see rule CchJQ1

Stabling

Parents must be in attendance. No-one under the age of 19 may be left on site without a parent. Horse boxes / tents need to be for family groups from the same residence.

Mucking out- bring own tools as none are kept on site

Warm Up areas

8 horses will be allowed into the various warm up areas at any time. A marked hacking area will also be available. Exercised areas will be marked. **Riders may not hack around the fields.**

1 adult per school in the warm up area at a time to put up jumps. Please ensure that they are available for everyone - do not hog them!

Arena Eventing classes. **Please make your own number and display in your own eventing bib.**

Dressage & SJ classes may **print numbers or bring a bridle number for each horse**. No paper numbers will be given out this year.

Prize Givings

There will be official **unmounted prize givings**. **Riders must be correctly dressed to receive prizes.**
