National Schools NSEA Combined Training Qualifiers

1st & 2nd placed team & 1-4th placed individuals will qualify for the **NSEA National Schools Championships 2025** October 2025

Class 1 Combined Training Individual Novice Qualifier Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 80cm

Class 2 Combined Training Intermediate Qualifier

Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 90cm

Class 3 Combined Training Open Qualifier

Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 1m

Teams 3 or 4 riders, jumping two different heights. Best 3 scores to count.
1 & 2 Novice Teams (2 x 80 & 2 x 90 riders)
2 & 3 Open Teams (2 x 90 & 2 x 1m riders)

Classes 1 – 3 Entry Fee £35 per person

Class 4 Prelim individual Dressage Qualifier BD Prelim 2 (2024)

Open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above

Class 5 Novice Individual Dressage Qualifier BD Novice 2 (2024)

<u>Horse / rider combinations</u> which have ever competed at Medium level or above may not compete in Novice classes. However, riders may compete on a different horse.

Classes 4 & 5 Entry Fee £22 per person NSEA Rules 2024-25

For 2025, there will be TWO team mixed height sections and THREE Individual qualifying sections. Teams are made up of 3 or 4 riders

1 Combined Teams Intermediate/ Novice (2 riders jump 80cm and 2 riders jump 90cm)

2 Combined Teams Open /Intermediate (2 riders jump 90cm and two riders jump 1m)

Team riders will automatically count as individuals.

All riders will ride the same test BD Dressage Test Prelim 2 (2024) before jumping in 3 height sections 80, 90 and 1m.

Grass Roots Qualifiers for the Grass Roots Regional Championships (see website for dates) as well as the NSEA Grass Roots Festival at Hickstead in August 2025 Classes 11-14 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply Entry Fee £22

Horse/rider combinations may compete in two consecutive height qualifying classes on the same pony 40 & 50 or 50 & 60 or 60 & 70cm

A GR rider may not jump in 70cm and 40cm

A rider is not eligible for GR if they are jumping 90cm and may only jump 60 and 70 GR classes if horse/rider have completed 5 x 80cm classes.

Class 11a/b 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on jumping penalties, placings separated on style marks. Not timed, although the maximum time in the arena is 4 mins.

40a) led, unled and running in close proximity with the pony.

40b) assisted- in the ring but does instructor not move with the pony Top 6 individuals in each section to qualify. Top 6 teams to qualify, which can be made up of riders in either section

Class 12 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time

Class 13 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 14 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Classes 15-17 Regional Points League Classes NSEA 30cm Rule applies Entry Fee £25

Top 6 placings in the RPL 70, 80, 90 classes qualify to compete at the RPL Individual Championships at NSEA GR RPL Championships at Hickstead in August.

Team Points- towards the regional points leagues, calculated at the end of the academic year, where the highest 4 schools will qualify for the NSEA Championships at Addington in October.

Class 15 70-75 cm RPL Teams & Individuals Open to all Single phase

Class 16 80-85cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 17 90-95cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

NSEA Rules – For the comprehensive Grass Roots Rules go to NSEA General Rules 2024-25 on the NSEA website. See below for eligibility in the height classes:

The purpose of the Grass Roots programme is to provide very novice riders with the opportunity to experience the excitement of competition. The rules are, therefore, kept as flexible as possible but, please embrace the "spirit" of the rules. Please do not use Grass Roots competitions as an easy opportunity to "pot hunt," as it is not in the spirit of the competition.

The top 6 teams & individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Regional Grass Roots Championships. Riders who have competed in affiliated show jumping or eventing at 80cm or above , Pony Club regionals at 80, BSPS or Trailblazers at Championships level at 80cm or individually at NSEA National Championships in October at 80cm are not eligible for Grass Roots Classes

Riders who qualify for the Grass Roots Championships and then subsequently jump themselves out of their qualification are able to upgrade their qualification to the NSEA RPL Individual Championships (70-90cm) which runs at Hickstead in August at the same time as the Grass Roots Championships)

I, the undersigned, in consideration of being permitted to be on the grounds of Coombelands Equestrian and Coombelands Racing Stables LLP (the "**Grounds**"), and being permitted to participate in various related activities while on the Grounds including participation in but not Limited to cross – country, arena eventing, show jumping, gallops and equine swimming pool, being permitted to be a spectator or in the vicinity of horses, a player, rider, trainer, owner, attendant, judge, collecting ring steward, arena party, taking lessons, walking or riding, stabling, livery, or grooming or in any other way handling horses (all of the foregoing by way of example and not by way of limitation) (the "Activities"), by execution of this General Release and Waiver of Liability hereby:

1. Understanding

Confirm that I understand and acknowledge that activities involving horses can be dangerous and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt. There is a significant risk that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from any such activities.

2. Release Waiver

Acknowledge that I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown and I voluntarily participate at **my own risk** and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in the Activities.

RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE, you or any of your Directors, Associates or employees, for any loss or damage, and any claims, including any claim for death or personal injury (other than caused by your negligence), or injury to me or my ponies, or loss of personal property, whether arising from control or supervision of spectators, providing or failing to provide medical care, first aid, emergency communications, emergency transportation, or design, maintenance or repair of any facility or anything or any other act caused by you or otherwise while I am in or upon the Grounds.

3. Risk of Personal Property

Confirm that all personal property kept, placed or left on or about the Grounds shall be at my sole risk as to loss, theft, injury or damage and you shall have no responsibility for such loss, theft, injury of damage for any such personal property (including but not limited to ponies, tack and vehicles).

4. Assumption of Risk

Acknowledge and agree that equestrian activities are dangerous and involve risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage and that such activities are extremely dangerous and hazardous. I consciously and voluntarily assume all such risks, dangers and hazards inherent in these activities.

I acknowledge that I need to be medically fit enough to participate in the Activities and that it is up to me to liaise with a doctor about this. I also acknowledge that I should not attempt any activities which are outside of my ability.

I accept full responsibility for myself, my guests, my pupils, my employees and my/their animals.

5. Damage

Agree to be wholly responsible for all damage caused by me, my guests, my employees, my animals, or anyone on the Grounds with my consent or at my request.

6. Insurance

Confirm that I have adequate insurance including £5,000,000 of third party public liability to protect my exposure and those of my horses. I further confirm that if I bring anyone employed by me to the Grounds I will have the appropriate employers' liability insurance.

If instructing or hosting a clinic, I hold the relevant insurance, including public and personal liability insurance.

7. Behavior

Confirm that I understand that you expect:

- (a) anyone attending the Grounds to behave and control their children and pets; and
- (b) that all players and riders will participate in an attitude of fair play, good sportsmanship and mutual respect amongst the spectators and players alike.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during any of the Activities and I agree not to consume alcohol or any mind altering drugs during any of the Activities while on the Grounds and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption.

I agree not to take drugs prohibited by law before, during or after any of the Activities.

I confirm that all my employees are legally allowed to work in the United Kingdom.

8. Safety Equipment

I agree to wear or use any recommended safety equipment while on the Grounds, in particular whilst mounted:

- (a) a helmet;
- (b) back protector; and
- (c) appropriate footwear.

9. Instructions

I agree:

- (a) to abide by, follow and adhere to all the rules, regulations and by-laws which apply to the Activities or at the Grounds or any instructions given to me or in relation to the Activities or the Grounds from time to time.
- (b) to follow the directions of any event organiser or official.
- (c) that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the <u>CANCELLATION</u> of my participation in the Activities and my immediate removal from my horse <u>NO MATTER</u> where that may occur.

10. Acknowledgement

Confirm that I have had sufficient opportunity to read this document and having carefully read and understood the above, I fully understand its terms and conditions and the risks set forth herein and agree to accept full responsibility for my exposure to such risks, whenever I use the **Grounds** and **Activities.** Furthermore, I acknowledge a full and complete understanding for the limitations of liabilities and waiver of certain rights that I may have and granting of releases contained herein and knowingly, freely and voluntarily consent thereto.
