**Arena 2: Grassroots Qualifiers** 

Class 1 30cm Cross-Pole Clear Round (may be led/assisted)

Entry Fee: £13 per combination

Class 2 40cm Team & Individual Qualifier (may be led/assisted)

Judged on style only. An additional prize will be awarded for the best horsemanship displayed by any rider.

Entry Fee: £23 per combination

Trophies: Master Monty Trophy and The Ryder Cup

Class 3 50cm Team & Individual Qualifier (may be assisted)

Optimum Time. An additional prize will be awarded for the best horsemanship displayed by any rider.

Entry Fee: £23 per combination

Trophies: The Cook Yarborough Cup and The Heynen Challenge Cup

Class 4 60cm Team & Individual Qualifier (un-assisted)

Single Phase: An additional prize will be awarded for the best horsemanship displayed by any

Single Phase. This class will be jumped in 2 sections: 10a) horses, 10b) ponies, but will be scored as one competition with the top 2 horses and the top 2 ponies to qualify.
