Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 80cm

Class 2 Combined Training Intermediate Qualifier

Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 90cm

Class 3 Combined Training Open Qualifier

Prelim = BD Prelim 2 (2024) SJ 1m

Teams 3 or 4 riders, jumping two different heights. Best 3 scores to count.

1 & 2 Novice Teams (2 x 80 & 2 x 90 riders)

2 & 3 Open Teams (2 x 90 & 2 x 1m riders)

Entry Fee £ 25.00

Medical cover £ 5.00 per rider

NSEA Rules 2024-25

For 2025, there will be TWO team mixed height sections and THREE Individual qualifying sections. Teams are made up of 3 or 4 riders

1 Combined Teams Intermediate/ Novice (2 riders jump 80cm and 2 riders jump 90cm)

2 Combined Teams Open /Intermediate (2 riders jump 90cm and two riders jump 1m)

Team riders will automatically count as individuals.

All riders will ride the same test BD Dressage Test Prelim 2 (2024) before jumping in 3 height sections 80, 90 and 1m.

Inter-Schools <u>Grass Roots Showjumping</u> Qualifiers 40-70cm & RPL Show Jumping classes 70-90cm

Classes 4 – 8 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

Horse/rider combinations may compete in two consecutive height qualifying classes on the same pony 40 &50 or 50 & 60 or 60 & 70cm

A GR rider may not jump in 70cm and 40cm

A rider is not eligible for GR if they are jumping 90cm and may only jump 60 and 70 GR classes if horse/rider have completed 5 x 80cm classes.

Class 4a/b 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted) Judged on jumping penalties, placings separated on style marks. Not timed, although the maximum time in the arena is 4 mins.

40a) led, unled and running in close proximity with the pony.

40b) assisted- in the ring but does instructor not move with the pony

Top 6 individuals in each section to qualify. Top 6 teams to qualify, which can be made up of riders in either section

Class 5 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time

Class 6 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 7 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Classes 8 - 10 NSEA 30cm Rule applies

Regional Points League Classes

Team Points- towards the regional points leagues, calculated at the end of the academic year, where the highest 4 schools will qualify for the NSEA Championships at Addington in October.

DRESSAGE

Tests at Championship Qualifiers 2024 (Team & Individual) all in 20x40m arenas as follows...

Class 10 BD Prelim 2 (2024)

Open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above

Class 11 BD Novice 2 (2024)

<u>Horse / rider combinations</u> which have ever competed at Medium level or above may not compete in Novice classes. However, riders may compete on a different horse.

Class 12 BD Elementary 1 (2024)

No restrictions on horse or rider

Teams

Teams shall be made up of 3 or 4 riders (best 3 scores to count) with up to two riders to compete in the prelim test and up to two riders in the novice test.

All team riders will automatically count for individual placings providing they are eligible (see NSEA 'Additional rules)

The top 2 teams & 4 Individuals will qualify for the Championships

If there is more than one section, a ride off will determine who qualifies, (or 1 team & 2 individuals per section)
