Classes 1 & 2 NSEA Grass Roots Rules apply

*Horse/rider combinations may compete in two consecutive height qualifying classes on the same pony
40 & 50 or 50 & 60 or 60 & 70cm*

A GR rider may not jump in 70cm and 40cm

*A rider is not eligible for GR if they are jumping 90cm and may only jump 60 and 70 GR classes if horse/
rider have completed 5 x 80cm classes.*

Class 1 - 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted) Optimum time

Class 2 - 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may not be assisted) Single phase

Class 3 - Mini 70-75cm Team & Individual Qualifier

(Riders to be aged under 14 on 1st January 2025)

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 4 - Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

Class 5 - Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 6 - 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

Class 7a/b - 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier

(2 x horses and 2 x ponies to qualify)

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

Entry fees: classes 1 & 2 £20

classes 3 - 7 £25

Medical cover included in entry fee
