Class 2: Warm Up 60cm (non-county Qualifier) as well as Grass Roots Qualifier (please specify which section you are in on your entry) Individual only

Class 3: Mini 70cm Team & Individual County Qualifier Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals (2025 Inter- County Mini Team Champions Kings, Taunton. Somerset)

Class 4: Novice 80cm Team & Individual County Qualifier Team & Individual Qualifier for the County finals (2025 Inter-County Novice team Champions Wellington College, Berks)

Class 5: Intermediate 90cm Team & Individual County Qualifier Team & Individual Qualifier for the County Finals

(2025 Inter-County Intermediate Team Champions Queen Mary's, N. Yorkshire)

Class 6: 1m Team & Individual County Qualifier
Team & Individual Qualifier for the County Finals
(2025 Inter-County Open Team Champions Heathfield CC, East Sussex)

Class 7a/b: 1.10m Individual County Qualifier. Class split into a) horses and b) ponies for the County Finals
