The highest placed team & individual for the relevant county will be given the title 'County Champion'

National Dressage Qualifier and RPL for teams and individuals from any county.

Those competing in the County Qualifier will also be eligible for national qualification.

**Top two teams and top four individuals will qualify for the Nationals at
Addington in October 2026**

Team Qualifiers for County and National Qualifiers

Teams of 3 or 4 with the best 3 percentage scores to count.

A horse/rider combination may only compete in one team.

Individual Qualifiers will run in conjunction with the team tests.

All tests may be called at qualifying events but not at the Championships. Dressage whips are allowed at qualifying events but not at the Championships.

Times will be on the NSEA website at least two days before the competition.

No refunds of entries after the publication of times (and see NSEA rules for full refund policy).

Classes may not run in this order on the day.

Class 1:

County Prelim Teams & Individuals (this class is not a National Qualifier)

For prelim riders who have never ridden above BD bronze prelim level, any novice level dressage (affiliated or unaffiliated,) open Pony Club or novice BE eventing.

Test: Prelim 1 (2024)

The winning team and individual from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals at Hickstead in May.

(2025 Inter-County Prelim Team Champions- The Chase School, Worcs)

Class 2:

County Open Teams & Individual & National Team & Individual Qualifier

Prelim section is open to horse & rider combinations that have not competed at British Dressage Elementary level or above. Novice section is open to all.

Teams are made up of 2 x prelim riders & 2 x novice riders

2a Prelim Team Riders (x2 max)

2b Prelim individual riders

2c Novice Team Riders (x2 max)

2d Novice individual riders

Test: Prelim 2 (2024)

Test: Novice 2 (2024)

The winning team and individual from each respective county will represent their county at the NSEA Inter County Finals at Hickstead in May.

(2025 Inter-County Open Team Champions – Mayfield, East Sussex)

The top two teams will qualify for the Nationals at Addington in October 2026

The top four horse/rider combinations in both the Prelim and the Novice will qualify for the Nationals at Addington in October 2025.

Class 3: Individual Elementary National Qualifier (if time permits)

Test: BD Elementary 1 (2024)

No restrictions on horse or rider (see NSEA rules for qualification criteria)
