Class 1 - 40cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be led/assisted)

Judged on jumping penalties, placings separated on style marks. Not timed

a) led, unled and running in close proximity with the pony.

b) assisted- in the ring but instructor does not move with the pony

Top 6 individuals in each section to qualify. Top 6 teams to qualify, which can be made up of riders in either section

Class 2 - 50cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may be assisted)

Optimum time

Class 3 – 60cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may **not** be assisted)

Single phase

Class 4 - 70cm Team & Individual Grass Roots Qualifier (may **not** be assisted)

Single phase

Class 5 - 70cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 6 - 80cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 7 - 90cm RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

Class 8 - 1m RPL Teams & Individuals Single phase

All classes are run single phase.
Team and Individual rosettes 1st-6th place

Classes 1-4 Grass Roots Qualifiers – NSEA Grass Roots rules apply

Top 6 teams and individuals at qualifiers will be eligible to compete at any Grass Roots Regional Championships (see NSEA website for dates) as well as the NSEA Grass Roots Festival at Hickstead in August. This competition is open to schools from all counties

Classes 5-8 – NSEA SJ rules apply

30cm rule applies, competition is open to schools from all counties and will count for RPL points.

Please ensure you are aware of the full rules of competition and rider eligibility, rules can be found on the NSEA website.

Start Times will be available on the NSEA website 2 days before the competition
